- [1] Copy pattern and cut out pieces as indicated. Refer to photo for colors or create your own!
- [2] Pin body to desired location. Using 3 strands of floss and a small running stitch, attach.
- [3] Referring to the diagram or photo, place the bottom feathers in place and pin.
- [4] Using 6 strands of floss, stem stitch down the center shaft of each feather. Using 6 strands of floss add the slanted barbs on either side of the shaft using straight stitches.
- [5] Referring to the diagram or photo, place the top feathers in place and pin. Embroider in the same manner as the bottom feathers.
- [6] Pin beak in place and using 3 strands of floss and a small running stitch, attach to owl's body.
- [7] Position eyes and attach to body using 3 strands of floss and a small running stitch.
- [8] Transfer eye markings to the eye background. Using 6 strands of floss embroider the eye lid using a stem stitch. Using 6 strands of floss, add eyelashes using straight stitches.
- [9] Position wings and pin in place. Using 6 strands of floss, attach wings using a small running stitch. Transfer wing detail and embroider using 6 strands of floss and a stem stitch.
- [10] Pin feet to owl. Using 3 strands of floss and a small running stitch, attach to owl. Using 6 strands of floss, use a straight stitch to separate talons. Go over the talon separators a second time to create a thick line.
